

**Accepting Applications for

(MSCAB) Positions**

The Nominating Committee is recruiting eligible and interested Mastick members to fill vacant MSCAB positions. The commitment varies depending on the position. Officers serve a one-year term while Directors serve a two-year term. Candidates must:
