Measures A & H Tax Exemption Forms

Owner-Occupants residents, 65 and older, are eligible to apply for an exemption from the Alameda Unified School District's (AUSD) Measure A & H Parcel Taxes. On June 7, 2005, the voters approved an extension and increase to Measure A, creating a \$189 parcel tax. On June 3, 2008, the voters approved a temporary emergency four-year parcel tax. Property owners already registered with AUSD received a **Renewal Form** in April. New applicants can pick up exemption forms in the Mastick Office or by contacting the AUSD Business Office at (510) 337-7066. **Application deadline is June 30, 2010.**
