**Transportation Office**

**AARP Online Driver Safety Course**

**AARP Driver Safety Program**

**AARP Driver Safety Program** is the largest classroom driver course specifically designed for motorists who are 50 and older! AARP offers two classroom formats which are offered on alternating months. The *standard* course taught in two, four-hour sessions over a two-day period on the first and second Wednesday (**July 7 & 14**) of the month from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm **or** the *refresher* course which is available to individuals that have taken the standard course within the last **four** years. The refresher course is offered on the first Wednesday (**August 4**) of the month between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm. *Preregistration is a must*. There is a \$12 per person fee for AARP members (AARP membership number required) and \$14 per person fee for non-AARP members. Preregistration is required in the Mastick Office. The registration fee is payable by check **ONLY** made payable to AARP. Ask your insurance agent about automobile discounts.

**Alameda County Paratransit Service**

East Bay Paratransit (EBP) is a public transit service for people unable to use AC Transit buses or BART trains because of a disability or a disabling health condition. AC Transit and BART established this service to meet requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). EBP transports riders to and from their destination in sedans or in vans equipped with a wheelchair lift.

**City of Alameda Premium Taxi Service**

Premium Taxi Service is available to individuals that are EBP-certified, 75 years of age or older, or 70 years of age or older without a driver's license. The City of Alameda contracts with local taxi companies to provide this service. The service provides a 50% discount for taxi rides with the City of Alameda's transportation provider. Eligible riders must purchase the required discount coupons in advance. *City of Alameda Paratransit Services funded by Measure B.*

**City of Alameda Paratransit Shuttle**

The City of Alameda offers a *free* shuttle service for Alameda residents' age 62 years and older or certified to use East Bay Paratransit or the Alameda Premium Taxi Service. This service provides riders with a way of getting to and from popular shopping areas, medical facilities, or visiting friends within Alameda. **Medical Return Trip Improvement Program**
