The MSCAB has received *funds and restricted donations* to be used to create a Scholarship Program. The funds are designated to help our current members defray a portion of the costs of classes and/or day trips. These Scholarship funds are available, *once per year*, to current Mastick members who qualify by meeting low income limits. The monies can offset up to 50% (not to exceed \$50) of fees for classes, trips and/or programs.
