Registration for Fall Classes ~ Tuesday, September 7

At Mastick Senior Center, fall registration begins **Tuesday, September 7, at 7:45 a.m.** (9:00 a.m. for Quilting classes). On this day, members may begin registering for fall classes (September - December) online by visiting www.alamedaca.gov/Departments/Recreation-Parks. Beginning at **9:00 a.m.**, staff will be available to assist you in-person or by phone **(510) 747-7500**. Chairs will be set up outdoors and members will be registered in order of arrival.

Property Tax Postponement Program

The CA State Controller's Property Tax Postponement Program allows homeowners who are seniors (62 years of age and older), blind, or have a disability to defer current-year property taxes on their principal residence. Homeowners must meet requirements, including having at least 40 percent equity in the home and an annual household income of \$45,810 or less. Program Guidelines

We are excited to see you and want to ensure your visit to the Center is a success. In an effort to maintain the safety and well-being of members and staff, please adhere to the following when visiting:

- Be sure to dress in layers, bring a hat, sunscreen, and anything necessary to provide for your own comfort.
